BIOTRANSFORM advances circular bioeconomy solutions at 4th consortium meeting in Helsinki, Finland

The BIOTRANSFORM project, a HORIZON Coordination and Support Action funded by the European Union, convened its 4th consortium meeting in Helsinki, Finland, on May 28-29, 2024. Hosted by the project coordinator VTT, the meeting brought together partners from across Europe to review progress, address challenges, and strategize for the future.

The first day of the meeting featured two working sessions aimed at enhancing collaboration and accelerating the project's impact.
